SERVICES INCLUDE:

- Substance Use Evaluation
- Care plans to address the following needs: substance use, child welfare involvement, housing and financial stability, criminal justice involvement, health/wellness of the parent, high risk pregnancy, and safe parenting
- Team staffing with our Board Certified Addictionologist to determine appropriate recommendations based on the individual's unique needs/circumstances
- Referrals to treatment for substance use & other needs
- Care coordination for substance use, child welfare, criminal justice, economic stability, and medical/mental health care
- Group and individual support with Certified Recovery Peer Specialists
- Evidence-based parenting to include Circle of Security Parenting
- Ages and Stages developmental screenings for babies
- Pre- and post-partum depression inventroy

The Women and Family Intervention Services program includes three recovery-oriented system of care (ROSC) components:

- 1. Family Intervention Services (FIS), which provides the tools for parents to develop substance-free lifestyles and strong family relationships.
- 2. Women's Intervention Services and Education (WISE), which assists pregnant and parenting women to ensure healthy moms, pregnancy, and children.
- 3. WISE Substance Exposed Newborn/Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (WISE-SEN), which supports families experiencing, or at risk for, SEN/NAS.
